An exciting new concept for public seating, the hm83 bench can be used as a dramatic stand-alone feature or linked together to form molecular, geometric arrangements. Constructed in pre-formed plywood on a stainless steel underframe and upholstered in CMHR foams, hm83 is built to withstand severe contract use.

Additional accessories are available to expand its versatility: a chrome bumper bar can be fitted to protect against damage from luggage and trolleys, while a metal under plate can be fitted to prevent concealment of terrorist devices.



Born in 1967, Simon Pengelly learned his furniture-making skills in his father's workshop becoming an award winning cabinet maker by the age of 15. He graduated from Kingston University in 1988 and set up his own studio in 1993. He is now regarded as one of the most prolific and talented designers working in the British furniture industry today. The hm83 range is one of a number of Pengelly's collaborations with Hitch Mylius.
